#### WATER PROTECTION

The Pathfinder II is designed as a rugged sports watch. Each watch is waterproof tested to 10 ATM (330 FT) and can be immersed in water, provided the crown is correctly screwed in. If the watch is regularly serviced and maintained, you can wear it in the shower, swimming, kayaking, etc., without worry.

#### CHOOSING THE RIGHT BAND

While leather bands are extremely comfortable, immersing them in water on a regular basis will make even the finest leather band wear out quickly, so we recommend a natural rubber or titanium band if you plan to routinely immerse the watch in water.

**CRYSTAL:** Your watch is fitted with a heat-tempered mineral crystal. Please note that while glass is heat-hardened, an impact with a hard or sharp object can scratch the crystal, or crack or shatter it. If this happens, return the watch to one of our Service Centers and the crystal can be replaced for a moderate charge. (Scratches and impact damage are not covered under warranty.)

A completely scratchproof sapphire crystal (now standard on S-Series models) is available at extra cost from our Service department.

#### TWO YEAR WARRANTY

Great care has been taken to ensure that your watch will give you many years of reliable service. It is guaranteed for two years against any defect caused by a fault in its manufacture\*. The best possible materials and components have gone into your watch. To keep it in top condition, please treat it with care and have it professionally serviced at regular intervals.

\* Loss or damage caused by accident, negligence, or opening, repair by unauthorized persons, as its cosmetic deterioration of the case or bracelet caused by wear & tear or abuse and damage caused by cracked or broken crystals.

#### SIX YEAR EXTENDED WARRANTY

After the 2-year warranty expires, we recommend that you extend your warranty by sending your watch to a St. Moritz Service Centre for a Full Service. (Typical cost £25). This includes: cleaning, lubrication and accuracy tuning.




**THANK YOU...** for purchasing the St. Moritz Pathfinder. This watch has been carefully designed to give you years of reliable service. It's design incorporates the latest watchmaking technology and features like a solid titanium case and anti-glare mineral crystal. Please let us know if you have any comments or suggestions as to how we might improve our products.

**USING THE SCREW CROWN** (C) Your watch has been equipped with a screw-down, locking crown. (C). This screws into the case like a submarine hatch, to ensure the most reliable possible waterproof seal. To set your watch, you must first unscrew the crown by turning it counter-clockwise 4-5 turns. It can then be pulled gently out from the case for setting. After setting or resetting the watch always ensure that you screw the crown back into the case by pressing it firmly into the case; then, applying a gentle pressure against the case, turn the crown clockwise 4-5 turns until it is snug against the case. Always ensure that it turns smoothly and is not cross-threaded. Do not overtighten! (Finger-tight will ensure a good water-proof seal.) If damage to the watch occurs due to a failure to screw in the crown correctly, such damage cannot be covered under warranty.

**SETTING THE TIME AND DATE** To set the watch, first unscrew the crown. Once unscrewed, the crown can be pulled out two "stops". The first position is the DATE / ALARM setting position, and the second position is the Time setting position. To ensure that the date changes

correctly, pull the crown out one stop, to the DATE / ALARM setting position. Turn the crown counter-clockwise until the date window at 3 o'clock shows yesterday's date. Then, pull the crown out one more stop to the Time Setting position and turn the hands forward until the date in the date window changes to the current date. Keep turning the hands forward until you reach the correct time. Once the time is set, press in and screw down the crown. NOTE: If you set the watch after 12 o'clock noon, make sure you turn the hands around the dial and past 12 o'clock (noon) to set the PM time. If you do not do this, the date will change at noon, instead of midnight.

**SETTING THE ALARM** To set the alarm, first unscrew the crown out one stop, to the DATE / ALARM setting position. Now turn the crown clockwise, so the ALARM hand (the hand with the red arrow tip) is aligned with the time you wish to wake up. Once the ALARM is set, press in a screw in the crown firmly.

**TURNING THE ALARM ON / OFF** Once the desired time has been set as outlined above, turn the alarm on by pulling out the

**THE SNOOZE FEATURE** Please note that if you do not turn off the alarm by pressing in button A, it will sound for approximately 10 seconds, then automatically shut off and go into snooze mode. This causes the alarm to sound several times at approximate 3 minute intervals.

**NIGHT-READING:** Your watch employs an amazing new luminous material called BACKOUT SUPERLUMINOUS. This technology allows you to read your watch at night, without pushing any buttons, so you do not need to use two hands. Just glance at your watch and read the time. Completely non-radioactive, BACKOUT SUPERLUMINOUS functions by charging from ambient light. The brighter the light, the faster and more powerful the "charge". When new, we recommend you set it in direct sunlight for 30 minutes to charge it up for maximum effect, but normal room lighting will generally charge your watch enough to be legible for

ALARM button (A). When the alarm sounds, turn it off by simply pressing the ALARM button (A) gently into the case.
